Student support MATTERS...

For Chris and Betsy Taggart of Cody, Northwest College has been an integral part of their charitable giving.

Not only are they relentless supporters of students and their success, but now they're championing a major project on campus – the new Student Center – as lead donors.

The two met as 18-year-olds at Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah, on the first day of the semester.

"My mom told me I shouldn't date a guy from Wyoming, or I'd end up living in a small town in Wyoming. She was right," Betsy joked.

Betsy grew up in the Detroit area, and Chris is a Powell native. From the beginning, education and philanthropy have been big parts of both of their lives.

"We dated all through our college years and got married after graduation," Betsy said. Together, the two moved to Cody and built a life, raising four children and becoming deeply involved in many areas of the community.

Betsy's late father, Stanford Stoddard, had the same spirit of generosity and zest for education. More than 20 years

ago, he had a dream to create a foundation that would serve as a vehicle to give back to organizations that were near and dear to their family's hearts.

"The purpose of the Stoddard Family Foundation is to support young people and school and help people get an education," she explained. "We've helped fund other projects, but most of the money from the Foundation has helped educate college students."

Their foundation funded a memorial scholarship at NWC for Betsy's late mother, Ann D. Stoddard, that has enabled many students to pursue their educational dreams. Betsy described her mother as someone who always noticed people and when they were in need.

"She wasn't a person who wanted accolades for doing something. My mother just didn't hesitate to do what she could for other people," she recalled.

Betsy explained that when her mother passed away 22 years ago, they began thinking of ways they could honor her, and Northwest seemed like a natural choice. The scholarship has served to perpetuate her generosity.

Chris' history with Northwest College dates back to a previous generation. His father, Hal, served as a founding member of the NWC Foundation Board of Directors in 1966. Chris was elected to the Foundation Board 2003 where he's provided executive leadership as treasurer and president, and currently chairs the Finance and Investment Committee. He also helped his mother establish a scholarship at Northwest honoring their family legacy with the Hal Snell Taggart and Phyllis Jameson Taggart Scholarship.

"The reason Betsy and I have become supporters of NWC is we have seen the difference it can make in a young person's life," Chris said. "Recently we had a single mother with small children tell us her scholarship allowed her to stay in school. In the long run, this support will produce amazing results for her family."

Over the years, the two have visited with many of their scholarship recipients, who feel it has given them a second chance at education and new beginnings. Each year, they look forward to attending the Scholarship Luncheon on campus in the fall, where they can meet the recipients of the Ann Stoddard and Hal and Phyllis Taggart awards.

"When helping out those at Northwest, we get face-to-face contact and you can see, 'yes, I really am helping to make a difference!"" Chris noted.

However, much of their passion for philanthropy and NWC's new student center stems from their own educational experiences.

"I just felt very lucky that I had the opportunity to go to school. I've always appreciated that I have a

college education," Betsy said. She studied textile fashion and merchandising and has assisted with costuming for movies and several local theater productions.

Having grown up in Powell, Chris has fond memories of spending time in the DeWitt Student Center. Throughout the years, they both attended various events in the building and recognized its need to be refreshed.

It was a building that gave the institution more than 50 years of memories. The new center, which is currently being constructed on the footprint of the old building, will be a place of belonging—one that captures today's Trapper spirit.

Chris and Betsy agree that the camaraderie among college students which generates lifelong friendships often takes place in a student center.

"A student center is such an important part of campus life... to have a great place to meet and eat a little food and be together," she noted.

Experience shows that students who are engaged and involved on campus are more likely to be retained and graduate. Currently, 54% percent of NWC students attend part-time, and many of them commute to campus each day. With a new center, all students will have a communal space where they can connect and grow.

With support of alumni and friends, Northwest can create a more vibrant campus—one where students can thrive and embrace their future with confidence.

"My mother had a saying, 'bloom where you are planted," Chris said. "We all have a duty to help our neighbors, and I invite you to join us."

New Student Center slated to open on NWC campus fall 2024

The heart of the Northwest College campus looks a little different these days. Where the DeWitt Student Center once stood is now a space that's being transformed into a more modern Student Center.

The original building gave NWC more than 50 years of memories, but was crumbling. Its infrastructure, once mighty and strong, was bending to water damage, irreparable pipes, and a rusted and crumbling façade.

To alleviate health and safety concerns, NWC began construction of a new building in May 2023.

The plan for a new Student Center dates to 2014 when it was identified as the number one priority in the NWC Facilities Master Plan. Following the goals set forth in the College's strategic plan, project planning kicked off in 2016, with college officials working closely with the State of Wyoming Construction Department to design a facility that would best meet the needs of NWC students and the community.



The new building will house NWC's dining hall and food service operations in addition to a coffee bar, student lounge, student activities center, and state-of-the-art study, and instructional spaces. Offices for resident life, campus security, and student success, an area for student clubs, and a multi-purpose community meeting room are also included.

An academic lab for the Outdoor Education and Aerial Adventure Operations programs is another feature, along with a new location for the NWC Recreation Co-Op, providing better access to the service NWC offers local community members.

The Wyoming Legislature has provided matching funds for the project, only the second time in NWC's 76-year history that it has received general fund appropriations from the state for capital construction. The Northwest College Foundation has committed to raising \$3.5 million in capital support for the project and has contributed an additional \$1.35 million to assist with costs.

The Timing Was Right

Attending school at Northwest College, a little closer to home, seemed like a good fit. Another bonus was the scholarships he was awarded.

"A lot of students had to take out loans. Because of the scholarships I received, I only had to pay \$35 the whole semester for tuition," he said.

Joe retired five years ago after working for 27 years as a Real Estate Appraiser in Nebraska and the Ross's relocated to Florida. While moving further away, Northwest College has continued to hold a special place in their hearts.

For the past 25 plus years, Joe and his wife Anni have been dedicated to giving to various NWC scholarships and campaigns such as the new student center.

"Anni and I have always believed in the importance of scholarships and giving back to benefit the students," Ross said. Joe and Anni funded scholarships at various institutions over the years including the University of Wyoming, Laramie County Community College (where Anni is an alum) and the local school district.

Last year, the Rosses made the decision to create and fund a new endowed scholarship, known as the Joe and Anni Ross Scholarship Endowment, for an NWC student majoring in an Agricultural academic program.

"I have so many fond memories as a student at NWC," he said.

Northwest College donors like Joe and Anni Ross are passionate and have strong convictions that every student should have educational opportunities which create a lasting impact.


